Day 1: Toronto

Arrive in Toronto and make your way to your city centre hotel accommodation.

Day 2: Toronto sightseeing

Located just a block from Parliament Hill, you will find an abundance of cultural activity with the National Arts Centre, Arts Court, La Nouvelle ScÃ"ne Gilles Desjardins, Ottawa Little Theatre, and numerous festivals and events. Shopping lovers come here to enjoy some of the biggest brand names in retail at the Rideau Centre some of which have been in the district for over 100 years.
