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### **Day 1: Arrive in Whitehorse**

Canada's Yukon is a legendary land famed for its Klondike Gold Rush history, pristine wilderness, and natural phenomena like the midnight sun and the northern lights. The territory teems with wildlife, mighty heritage rivers, and a vibrant arts and culture scene that embodies the spirit of the north. Today, take advantage of your free day to explore the captivating city of Whitehorse, the vibrant heart of this extraordinary region.

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### **Day 2: Wildlife & Hot Springs Tour**

Today you will visit the Yukon Wildlife Preserve where you'll have the opportunity to view and photograph wildlife in its natural habitat. Dall sheep, bighorn sheep, mountain goats, mule deer, wapiti (elk), woodland caribou, wood bison, musk-ox, moose, arctic fox and even lynx can all be seen on this tour. It's a photographer's and naturalist's dream to see Yukon's wildlife up close and you will be in the front row to learn about wildlife living year-round in the True North. To cap off a great day, we travel to the nearby Eclipse Nordic Hot Springs. The outdoor hot springs pool provides a warm sanctuary amid any cold weather and is a must-do activity while visiting Whitehorse!

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### **Day 3: Whitehorse to Dawson City**

Today you get the chance to experience the friendly service of Air North on your flight to Dawson City. Dawson City is an eclectic and vibrant northern community on the banks of the Yukon River. Dawson City boasts a mixture of First Nations Heritage and Gold Rush History blended with an active Gold Mining and a thriving Arts scene. This evening tour from Dawson City includes transportation in one of our quality tour buses to the top of the Midnight Dome, where you experience breathtaking views and plenty of stunning photo opportunities. Enjoy some cultural and historical information about Dawson City and the Klondike along the way on this tour. Our Midnight Dome tour is a must-see for any visitor to Dawson!

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### **Day 4: Dawson City to Inuvik with Goldfields Tour**

On this morning tour, you'll learn about the history of gold in Dawson City! The day begins with a tour of Dawson City, followed by a tour of the Gold Fields. Then, we visit Dredge No. 4 Historical Site. Your friendly tour guide tells you all about the history of Dawson City and the gold rush. You will then board your 1 hour 10 minute flight to Inuvik and collect your hire car that you will have for the next 3 days. Located 2 degrees north of the Arctic Circle, Inuvik is a place worth seeing.

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### **Day 5: Self-Drive to Tuktoyaktuk Day Trip**

Today you drive on the recently built Mackenzie Valley Highway all the way to the Arctic Ocean. Be amongst the early visitors to travel on this road from Inuvik to the community of Tuktoyaktuk on the Arctic Ocean. The all-season highway opened on November 15, 2017, after four years of construction. Prior to the road, Tuktoyaktuk was only accessible by air during summer and by ice road in the winter. This unique experience is very special as you drive on Canada's only road to the Arctic Ocean. The locals refer to Tuktoyaktuk as 'Tuk', and here, you can experience and learn the ways of life of the people who also call it 'home'. Local landmarks and other points of interest include the Lady of Lourdes Schooner, Traditional sodhouse, local churches, Distant Early Warning Site and the

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Trans Canada Trailhead site. Spend time on the seaside to dip your toes in the Arctic Ocean and experience the vastness of the Beaufort Sea.

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### **Day 6: The Famous Dempster Highway Self-Drive**

The Dempster Highway is Canada's road at the top of the world. It crosses the Arctic Circle and winds through some of the most beautiful and remote wilderness scenery in North America. Starting outside Dawson City, Yukon, and stretching 740 km to Inuvik in the Northwest Territories, the Dempster is an all-weather gravel road with two ferry crossings. The best time for reliable driving weather is June through September when the days are long and warm. There are two river crossings, with free ferry service in the summer and fall, and winter ice bridges. Tsiigehtchic, at the confluence of two rivers, is your destination for today offering a magnificent panoramic view of the Mackenzie and the Arctic Red Rivers. Stop en route at Gwich'in Territorial Park on your way back to Inuvik.
